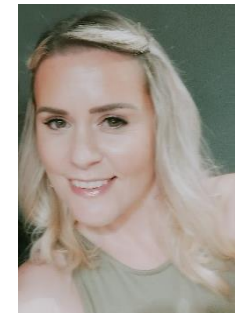

### English

- In English this term we will be focusing on our class text- Black Dog by Levi Pinfold.
- The children will produce a variety of text types including non-chronological reports, newspaper articles, stories and descriptive writing.
- The focuses for writing this term will be; fronted adverbials and using a range of different sentence openers such as time, manner and place.
- Our main focus will be extending our knowledge of clauses and introducing different sentence structures.
- Our whole class text will be Ratburger by David Walliams

### Maths

- This term our Maths will focus on enhancing and building the children's mathematical skills through- number and place value, addition and subtraction, multiplication and division.
- The children will also be learning their multiplication tables daily up to 12x12 – Y4 will complete a multiplication check in Summer term.
- We will continue to practice their mental maths through our maths assessments.
