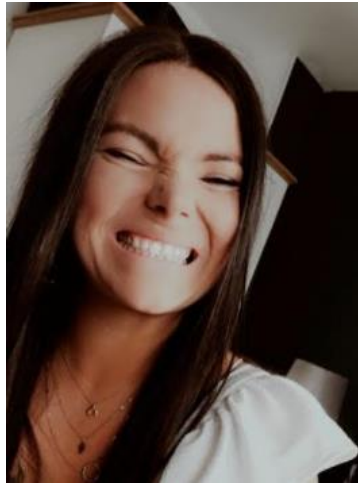

### English

The children will be reading and producing writing using a selection of materials: A classic novel, a quality text, letters and explanation texts. They will identify key features of the text and develop an understanding of its purpose.

Also, they will be reading *The Lion, the Witch and the Wardrobe*, a classic novel, and discussing the details of the story. Our other focus text this term is *Holes* by Louis Sachar. Using these texts, the children will write a detailed character description and an informal letter from a character's perspective.

### Maths

At the start of the term, our main focus will be on number and place value, addition, subtraction, multiplication, division and Fractions. At the end of Autumn term we will also focus on Geometry including position and direction.

### Science

This term's topics include light and electricity and the children will be focusing on learning about how to carry out a fair test and exploring light and how it travels. We will also investigate how we see objects by light entering the eye and the children will also experiment with electricity and circuits.

### History and Geography

We will be introducing the topic of Ancient Civilisations this term, where the children will explore some of the different civilisations such as Ancient Greece, Ancient Sumar and Ancient China. However, they will focus mainly on Ancient Egypt and the children will develop their sense of chronology and understanding of the achievements of this civilisation. They will also investigate the impact these achievements have had on the world and modern day life.

The children will be learning about longitude and latitude and the different hemispheres of Earth. They will learn about time zones and compare different parts of the world in terms of human (man-made) and physical (natural) features. All of these areas of geography will overlap with our Ancient Civilisation topic.
