Safeguarding means:

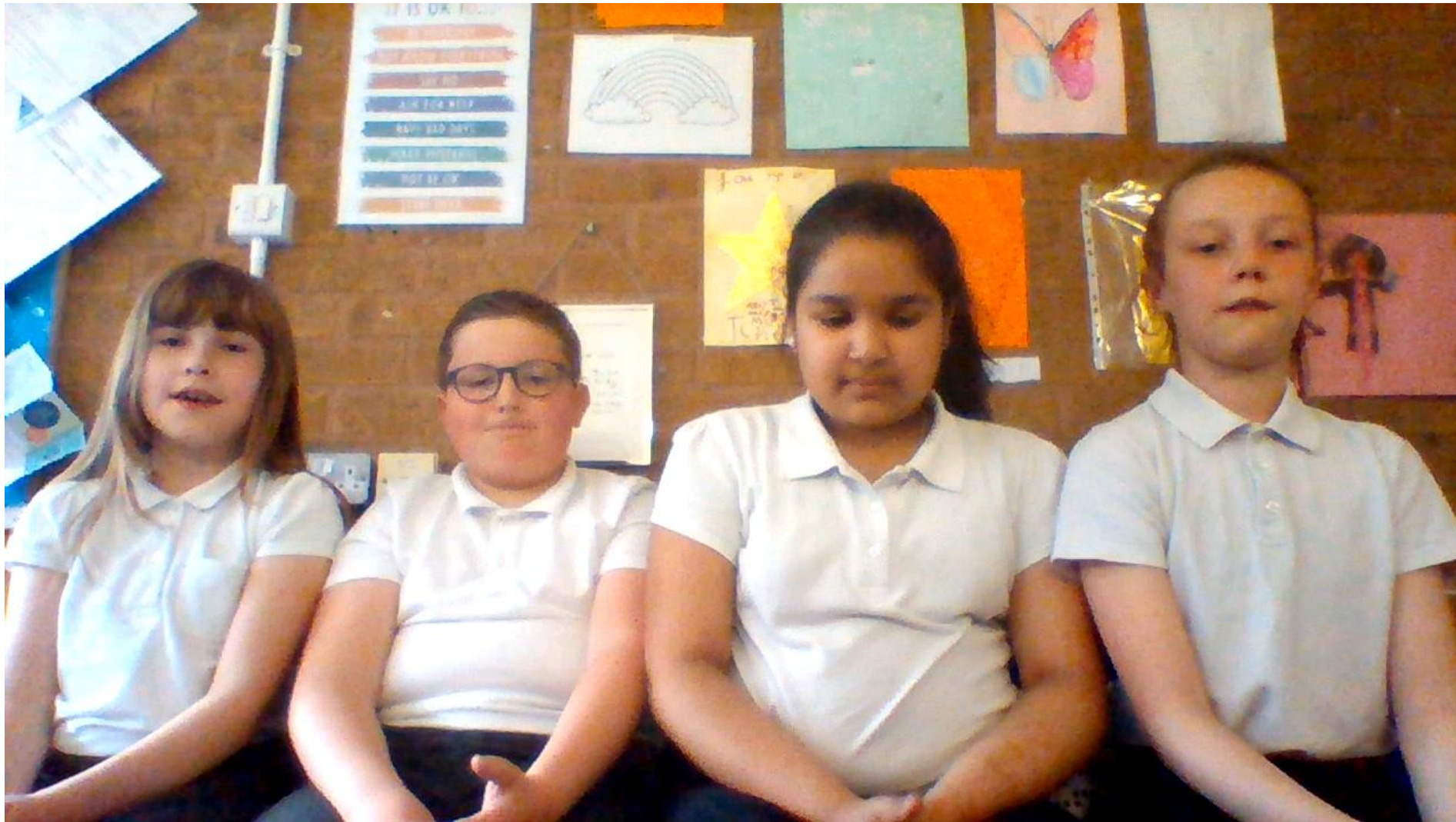
- - protecting children from abuse and maltreatment

- - taking action to enable all children and young people to have the best outcomes.
