Please remember that next Friday we have an INSET day. We break up for Christmas holidays next Thursday 17th and return back to school on Monday 4th January.



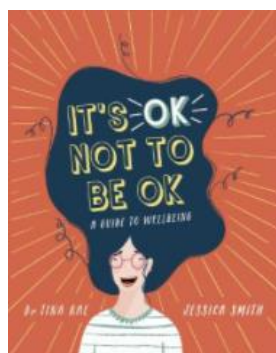
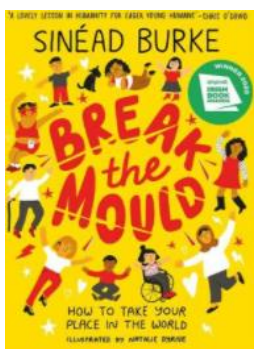
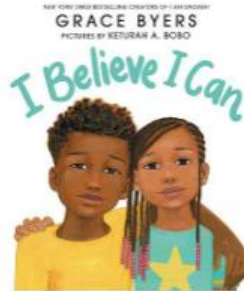
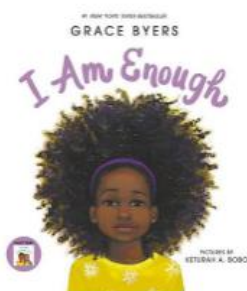
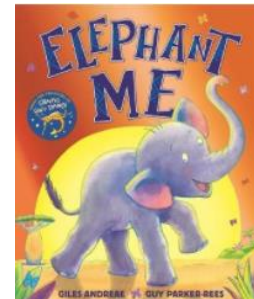
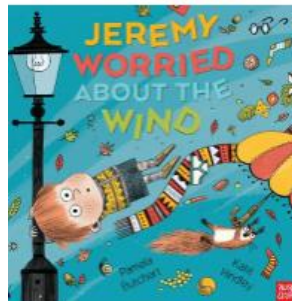
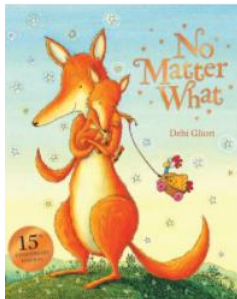
Reading

Teachers will usually assess children's work over a number of weeks to decide whether they're ready for a pen licence.

To get a pen licence, children need to:

- Using a correct pencil grip
- Writing on the line
- Joining letters correctly
- Starting each letter in the correct place
- Keeping letters the same size
- Forming letters with the correct shape
- Leaving appropriate gaps between words
- Ensuring that ascending and descending strokes are the right length
- Writing clearly enough for other people to read their work

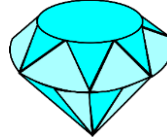
ENDGAME EDITOR
